LITTLE TERRORIST **by Ashvin Kumar (UK)**

The Prix UIP is an initiative by UIP and the European Film Academy in co-operation with twelve festivals throughout Europe. The prize includes a financial donation of € 2,000 and an automatic nomination in the short film category of the 2005 European Film Awards taking place in Berlin on December 3, 2005.

The winner was selected by the International Jury from among the short films participating in the festival's World Cinema section.

LITTLE TERRORIST is about a 10-year-old Pakistani boy who crosses the borders by mistake with no way of getting back.

LITTLE TERRORIST is the first short film to be nominated for the European Film Awards 2005. Throughout the next year, it will be joined by eleven other short films nominated at the following festivals all over Europe: Valladolid International Film Festival (Spain), Festival d'Angers – Premiers Plans (France), Berlin International Film Festival (Germany), Tampere Film Festival (Finland), Cracow Film Festival (Poland), Norwegian Short Film Festival Grimstad (Norway), International Short Film Festival Vila do Conde (Portugal), Sarajevo Film Festival (Bosnia-Herzegovina), Edinburgh International Film Festival (UK), Venice International Film Festival (Italy), and International Short Film Festival in Drama (Greece)
